General Session and Business Meeting

The Spring 2004 conference was held in the Radisson Riverwalk Hotel in Tampa, FL.

Sue Ranew, President, called the business meeting to order. The following members of the FASPA Board were present: President Sue Ranew, Immediate Past President Bill Owens, President-Elect Harriet Konstantinidis, Secretary Julie Reno, Treasurer Candy Southern, Program Director Chuck Bowersox, Non-Instructional Representative Barbara Melanson, Legislative Director Diane Walker, Director Rubye Howard.

Immediate Past President Bill Owens presented appreciation plaques to the board for their contributions to FASPA during his presidency. On behalf of FASPA, Sue Ranew presented a gift to Bill Owens and thanked him for all his work as FASPA president.

The minutes of the Fall Conference 2003 were approved. Total roll call responses for the fall conference were 184. President Ranew reminded everyone of the FASPA website at www.fasa.net/faspa. Treasurer Candy Southern gave an update on the fund balance. Balance brought forward from Fall 2003 was \$63,824.74. Deposits totaled \$26,190. Expenditures were \$17,767.49. Checkbook balance is \$72,247.25. Certificate of Deposit as of 1-1-04 was \$6,567.79. Total assets as of 3-1-04 = \$81,815.04. A motion was made, seconded and approved to accept the information given by Candy Southern on the fund balance.

A reminder was made for every member to turn in a conference evaluation form. The FASPA Board reviews these forms and changes/suggestions are considered for future sessions.

With no additional business to be considered, the meeting adjourned.
